



ABOUT SIGNING THE MEMBER FORM

Thank you for becoming a member of the Massachusetts Coalition for Public Charter Schools. Below are answers to some common questions about our membership forms and membership in our coalition.

1. Signing a member form simply confirms that the Massachusetts Coalition for Public Charter Schools may list you publicly as a member of our statewide coalition of Massachusetts parents, teachers, education advocates, community leaders, businesses, organizations, and individuals who support the campaign to improve educational opportunities for students across our state by providing increased access to public charter schools.
2. Signing a member form does not obligate you to contribute time or money, attend any meetings or make any public statements. Members are welcome to become more actively involved in coalition activities. However, any further involvement beyond being listed publicly as a supporter is entirely voluntary.
3. To show the breadth of our membership, lists of our members may be used in materials such as fact sheets, brochures, letterhead and possibly in advertisements. By signing this member form you are giving permission for our coalition to list your name publicly as a member and supporter of our campaign. All statements in our campaign material will be based on verifiable facts and information and all publications and activities of our coalition will be conducted in strict compliance with all relevant state laws and regulations.
4. All lists of individual members will note that any titles and affiliations are for identification purposes only and do not imply the endorsement of affiliated businesses or groups unless expressly indicated.
5. Member contact information will be used solely for communications between our coalition and our members. Member addresses and other contact information will not be sold or provided to any other groups, organizations or businesses.
